

**News and Prayer Requests from  
Charles Barr Johnston in Northern Argentina**



**November 2014**

Thank you very much for your prayers. Please continue to pray for the ministers we trained in the Juarez zone. Pray for Juan vicar of Juarez with his wife Sergia and Deaconess Elena in Chiriguanos and Tuqui vicar of Yema and his wife Rosa. Besides looking after the congregation in Juarez, Juan every fortnight goes to Quemado, which is 115 kilometres from Juarez, to look after the isolated and small congregation there. Tuqui is getting older and his vehicle hardly works but he gets to Chiriguanos each month to lead the Holy Communion Service in that church. Elena who has always been very good with children now has a growing young people's work going. Please pray for them all.

Pray also for the ministers in Salta. Bishop Nick has been trying to get a monthly pastors meeting going. The senior minister is a medical doctor Hugo who now is vicar of both San Andres and San Pablo. I go to both these 2 churches each week. Miguel is the youngest of these ministers. He became vicar of Principe de Paz in March 2013. Juan and Nadia together with Emi and Noelia lead the young people's work in this church. They and other young people from there come to my home Bible studies as do several young people and some older ones from San Andres. Another Juan is the minister who has been vicar for longest. I don't go to his church in Cristo el Senor or to Principe de Paz because the volume of the music in both these churches would deafen me. Rodolfo is the vicar of San Felipe which is the one with the smallest congregation. Since 2013 they have only had house meetings and none in the church building. Please pray for them all, including the retired vicar Jose who used to be the vicar of San Pablo. All these ministers are quite elderly with the exception of Miguel. Please pray for younger leaders for the future.

Pray also for Carlos who goes to our Bible studies and was recently converted. He has never been to an Evangelical church. But he has just started going to San Pablo. Please pray that he will continue to do so and that his wife Mercedes may also start going. She also professed faith in Christ fairly recently. I give them a pastoral follow up visit each Saturday. Carlos continues to come to our Bible study each week but Mercedes has stopped coming.
