We started College classes on February 21st with workshops in Dance and Physical Expression for our 19 Second Year students. Here you can see some photos of the activities we carried out.



Meanwhile, our 14 Third Year students were spending two weeks in state schools helping preschool teachers and getting to know the children. They have now returned to College to prepare the lessons they will be giving to the pupils.

Thank you for your prayers! We now have some excellent news to share with you. We have 34 First Year students (and we are continuing to receive calls from other interested people)! Their classes started on March 14th as did those of our Fifth Year students. Unfortunately, only 2 students applied for the Fourth Year course and so we haven't been able to open it this year. Please pray that we may be able to do so next year.

Thanks to your donations, FEISA is able to help some students who want to study with us but who, for various reasons, need financial help. Although our FEISA fees are not very high, the poor economic situation of Paraguay means that only 3 out of every hundred young people are able to pursue third level studies.

The following 6 First Year students have all received scholarships with your help.



Karen Redondo is the second of four siblings. She needs help to cover her fees as her father is the only working member of the family, and although he has a photocopying machine set up, his income varies from week to week depending on demand. This can be low.



Ruth Bianca Olmedo has 3 brothers. Her father is a maintenance worker in a hospital and her mother works in the kitchen. Unfortunately, her mother has an illness which affects her bones and she has to buy very expensive medicine.
