Peru

Jesús es el Camino (Jesus is the Way)

Police Captain Oscar Ugarte lay in his prison cell, his life in tatters. One shot from his gun had led to his being divorced by his wife, abandoned by family and friends, sacked from his job and facing twenty five years in jail. He was alone and crushed.

In success he had not been a religious man, but in despair - a bit like the thief on the cross - he turned in repentance to God. Although there was no human agent to present him the Gospel, things started to change in his life, the first sign being an element of hope and peace.

After a few months, some missionaries visited the prison and, on hearing his story, presented him the Gospel message which he joyfully embraced. They also gave him the SEAN course **Abundant Life** which he devoured and began to put into practice. Other prisoners, seeing the change in his life, began to open up to the Gospel and also to accept Jesus as Saviour and Lord.

After several years the prison church passed the hundred mark, and Oscar continued his SEAN studies course by course as he pastored the new flock. One day a Peruvian mission team entered the prison to support this effort, and to Oscar's astonishment one of the team was an attractive woman who had been one of his many lovers in his earlier life. After a long and emotional sharing of their new found faith she told Oscar how happy she was to see him now as a Christian and asked him, if he would like to meet his nine year old daughter Patricia, fruit of their past affair and whom Oscar did not even know existed!

Miracles continued to happen, when out of the blue, Oscar's case was reviewed. It was concluded that his shot had been in self-defence, and that his conviction had resulted from internal grudges against him. On leaving prison Oscar got a job as a security guard, married Patricia's mother and continued in active Christian service.

One day, he was asked to take over a small struggling congregation on the outskirts of Lima, the capital of Peru. When he arrived, the congregation of thirty halved, as many refused to accept him as Pastor. He persevered and remembering his SEAN training in prison, immediately set up his congregational Bible Institute to disciple new believers and train new workers.

Over the past decade, his congregation "Jesús es el Camino" (Jesus is the Way) has grown to over three hundred active and trained members.

Instead of making his church grow further, Oscar has preferred to reach out and share their blessings with other small struggling congregations and help them to grow. For this they have purchased a bus, and every Sunday afternoon they send out a team of fifty trained evangelists to work alongside the members of these other churches to visit people in their homes.



The bus and cars with team going out to support another congregation in door to door visitation. This ministry has recorded five thousand professions of faith.

In this way, the other congregations are also growing and adopting SEAN courses to disciple and train their members. Indeed - "Jesús es el Camino" (Jesus **IS** the way!!)

In the year that we celebrate SEAN's 40th birthday, we also have witnessed the passing into glory of Peggy Barratt (1923 – 2011) the wife of our Founder, the late Tony Barratt. Many of us were privileged to share in a beautiful service of 'Thanksgiving' for Peggy's life on Tuesday, 28th June in Axmouth Church, Devon, England.

Terry, their eldest son, recently found a highly significant entry in one of his dad's 5-year diaries. The entry was made in the city of Tucumán, Argentina, on 14th July 1971.

It says simply... **"I am to direct the Extension Ministry"**

During the 1950's and 1960's Tony Barratt's great passion for the churches served by the South American Mission Society was the training of their members for leadership. For the vast majority, training in Residential Colleges was not possible or practical. Tony realised that only locally-based training by Extension would serve the purpose, and that the training had to be accessible to all, not just to those with a good education.

He prepared a paper, in which he set out his vision, for presentation at a Consultation on 'Education by Extension' convened by Bishops and other Mission Leaders of the South American Mission Society in Tucumán in 1971. The Consultation concluded that Tony should be asked to direct the 'Training by Extension' Ministry – hence that entry in his diary on 14th July 1971. **We believe that was the day that SEAN was born!**

"It gradually became apparent that this new ministry was destined by God to circle the world. I suppose at the time of writing his book, at almost any moment of day or night, students somewhere are opening their SEAN Study Books with eager anticipation of learning more about their faith."

How true today, must this statement be, as student numbers have continued to grow! Finally, that important Consultation in 1971, was also the occasion of the ordination as presbyter of our Director, Terry Barratt. So this year is also his 40th anniversary as an ordained minister in God's church.

'Congratulations, Terry! The Lord be with you!'

Now, forty years on and as we remember Peggy Barratt with thanksgiving we gain further insight into those very early days through several quotations from her book **"The Humming Bird Nest"**...

"Now that Tony was officially recognised as the leader for this new project, he could begin to seek much

needed reinforcements to speed things up. He wanted colleagues who shared his passion to make top-quality theological training available to the simplest of our national leaders."

"We discovered that an intellectual battle was being waged between two conflicting systems of educational technology; all the pundits at that time considered them to be mutually exclusive. The first of these was "programmed" instruction, the second was "open-ended" group discussion. As we prayed over the approach we should take, Tony felt God prompting him to experiment by marrying these two methods in a single course.

Firstly, each student would be given his or her copy of a "programmed" self-instructional text. From this text they would be asked to cover several lessons a week at home, each student proceeding at his or her own pace.

"This grass-roots educational programme was named "Seminario por Extensión Anglicano", or "SEAN" for short. When SEAN spread far beyond the boundaries of the Anglican Church and became an interdenominational and international body, we changed its name to "Study by Extension for All Nations".

Secondly, the programme would include weekly open-ended group discussion of all the points the students had learned in their home studies. Each group would have roughly five to eight students directed by a group leader. The leader would be supplied with a special Group Leader's Manual with aids to stimulate lively group discussion etc

Over 1,000 students completed Compendium book 1 thru 6.




Uganda

We heard the Good News in 1998 in South Gobi province, and I became a believer.

I first came across the TEE course with the title, 'Abundant Life'. The title spoke to me. I was the son of a family of shamans. I had Buddhist/shamanist leanings myself. But this book was not 'religious'. I wanted to know more about this 'Abundant Life', so I studied with great interest.

Later I saw the potential of this material for training.

Although we started off meeting in a *ger* now we have a church building that can seat 200 people. Praise the Lord!

It is clear that TEE's structured training results in the growth of churches, and the growth in maturity of believers.

The churches in the provincial centre are using this training effectively, and in the future, we look forward to training at all levels throughout the province. There are so many advantages to using TEE!

I love and support MSTEE. In South Gobi we have a great Coordinator, whose name is Haisandai. I don't lead groups now myself, but I support them as a pastor.

How do we overcome problems that arise? We pray with fasting. There's early-morning prayer, and there's night prayer. We overcome by prayer.
