GREATER OPENNESS TO GOD: We both sense and are seeing a new attitudes and openness to God, in the life and fellowship of the congregation.

INSTANCES OF MUTUAL FORGIVENESS: Outstanding difficulties with individuals have been talked over and sorted out with mutual forgiveness.

A NEW PCC: As from October there is a new PCC.

It is a good group that promises to function well in the challenges ahead. Working in the administration and coordination of “La Resurrección” community under God’s guidance.



GOD HAS BEEN BLESSING AND ENCOURAGING OUR CHURCH COMMUNITY IN SPECIAL WAYS.

- **THROUGH HEALING:** Juanita, whose hands were locked in a fist position from arthritis, was healed, and her hands recovered their movement. From being a very quiet and reserved person, she now uses every opportunity to speak about her Lord.



- **THOUGH FREEING LIVES:** Danef, after 16 years of alcoholism and promiscuous living, has been freed, and is now rejoicing in Christ with a completely changed life, totally surrender to God.



- **THROUGH HEALING MARRIAGES:** In the meeting for married couples we have seen people receiving healing in different areas of their lives and relationships.



- **THROUGH GOD’S ENCOURAGEMENT:** Gods work in our life and the life of the church is encouraging and challenging us all.

THROUGH SPECIAL TIMES OF PRAYER: We celebrated half a Night vigil (19:00 to 00:00 hrs.). We joined as a congregation for prayer and exhortation on God’s demand to live a life of holiness, both as individuals and as a body. After falling on our knees in repentance, we came away encouraged by Gods word to us that in his Holly Spirit we have all we need to live a life of holiness.



THERE IS HUNGER FOR GOD'S WORD: Many people continue in the Bible Study groups, and others want to start. Danny has seen particular enthusiasm and interest in the Abundant Life course he leads.

- There is a great interest in studying the word of God in small groups in a systematic way. The SEAN material has been of great blessing as a tool to disciples and train new and old Christians, we have in all about 50 people weekly setting apart time to drink from his word (Psalm 42, Psalm 119:71-75)



WE CAN'T STAY QUIET: One couple, who don't attend church yet, but attends a Bible Study. They also have been part, of a very conservative religious group for married couples. Though very new Christians, the woman spoke up at this group meeting to refute something that was being taught, asking if that truth was in the Bible. The leader was forced to admit that those dogmas were not in the Bible, but formed part of their tradition.

INCREASING NUMBERS: We praise God for the increased numbers and interest of children and pre adolescent attending to Sunday School, the photo show the oldest group.
