HAVE 3 HRS EVERY WEEK, WHERE WORKSHOPS TAKE PLACE = EDUCATION REINFORCEMENT, COMPUTER STUDIES AND LABOUR BENEFIT ASSISTANCE

THESE WORKSHOPS TAKE PLACE EVERY THURSDAY FROM 9-12 HS AT THE PLACE WE HAVE FOR THIS PURPOSE, IN COLÓN. THEY'RE OFFERED FOR A WHOLE YEAR AND AFTER THAT TIME, OTHER YOUNGSTERS ARE APPROACHED IN ORDER THAT THEY MAY HAVE ACCESS TO THIS POSSIBILITY — WHICH ALLOWS THEM TO ACQUIRE THE NECESSARY TOOLS TO ENTER THE LABOUR TASK FORCE.

### Second group of Volunteers

On November 18th, the first activity for the 2014 group of Volunteers started at the San Pablo Home in Progreso. This home accommodates 16 teenagers of both sexes, with 24- hr attention/coverage.



This year's Project was to improve the room where the youngsters meet. It's a room which needed painting inside and out. The task was undertaken by volunteers, together with the youngsters who live there – which gave them a sense of achievement and a desire to improve the space they share. The facade was whitewashed and pieces of furniture were repaired.





The day ended with a meal, offered by the Home and was a good opportunity for the youngsters to share with the instructors.
