
## Summer Daily Prayer for Mission



## Prayers based on Colossians 4:2-4

"Devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful and thankful. And pray for us, too, that God may open a door for our message, so that we may proclaim the mystery of Christ, for which I am in chains. Pray that I may proclaim it clearly, as I should"

Day 1 - Theme: Perseverance

As we begin this prayer diary, let us reflect on Paul's resilience and unwavering commitment to the mission, even while in prison. May we too, in the face of challenges, find strength to persevere and continue the work of spreading the Gospel where ever we are and for those in South America.

Day 2 - Theme: Unity

Today, let us pray for unity in the local Anglican churches in South America. May they work together in harmony, supporting one another in their outreach endeavours, and may their united efforts bring about transformative change in the communities they serve.

Day 3 - Theme: Boldness

In prayer today, let us ask for courage and boldness for the the local church as they share the message of Christ in different South American contexts. May they speak with conviction and clarity, overcoming any fears or obstacles, and may their words touch the hearts of those who hear, leading them to know Jesus.



Day 4 - Theme: Open Doors

Pray that God would open doors of opportunity for mission work in South America. May the local church members encounter receptive hearts, favourable circumstances, and divine appointments that enable them to share the love of Christ and establish new communities of faith.



Day 5 - Theme: Discipleship

Today, let us intercede for the growth and maturity of new believers in South America. Pray that they would be rooted in the Word, guided by the Holy Spirit, and mentored by experienced disciples. May they become strong disciples themselves, carrying the Gospel forward.

Day 6 - Theme: Empowerment

Pray for the empowerment of local leaders in the Anglican Church of South America. Ask that God would equip them with wisdom, discernment, and spiritual gifts necessary to lead and shepherd their congregations effectively, fostering a missional mindset in their communities.

Day 7 - Theme: Provision

As we pray today, lift up the financial and material needs of the SAMS Ireland and the Anglican Church in South America. Ask God to provide abundantly, so that resources for

outreach, education, and discipleship efforts may be readily available to further His kingdom.

Day 8 - Theme: Healing and Restoration

Intercede for the physical, emotional, and spiritual healing of individuals and communities in South America. Pray that God's love and compassion would bring restoration to broken lives, mend relationships, and bring hope to those who are hurting or marginalised.

Day 9 - Theme: Education and Training

Today, let us pray for the development and expansion of educational and training programs within the Anglican Church in South America. Ask that God would raise up skilled teachers and mentors who can equip believers for effective ministry and leadership.

Day 10 - Theme: Evangelism

Pray that a spirit of evangelism would permeate the Anglican Church in South America. May every member embrace their role as witnesses and ambassadors for Christ, sharing the Gospel boldly and authentically, both in word and deed.

Day 11 - Theme: Indigenous Communities

In prayer today, lift up the indigenous communities in South America. Ask for cultural sensitivity, understanding, and the empowerment of local believers to reach out with the love of Christ, valuing and preserving their unique heritage.

Day 12 - Theme: Justice and Advocacy

Pray for justice and advocacy efforts within the Anglican Church in South America. May the Church be a voice for the voiceless, standing against social injustice, exploitation, and inequality, and working towards the transformation of society.

Day 13 - Theme: Cross-Cultural Ministry

Intercede for those who serve in cross-cultural contexts within South America. Pray that they would have a deep respect for diverse cultures, be sensitive to local customs, and



effectively communicate the Gospel in ways that resonate with the hearts and minds of those they encounter.

## Day 14 - Theme: Youth and Children

Today, let us pray for the youth and children in South America. Ask that God would raise up strong leaders and mentors who can disciple the younger generation, instilling in them a passion for Christ and a desire to impact their communities for good.

## Day 15 - Theme: Revival and Renewal

Pray for a spiritual revival and renewal within the Anglican Church in South America. May the Holy Spirit move mightily, drawing people closer to God, igniting hearts with passion for His mission, and bringing transformation to individuals, congregations, and entire regions.

Day 16 - Theme: Relationship Building

Intercede for meaningful relationships to be built between local churches and the local communities in South America. Pray for trust, respect, and deep connections to be formed, enabling the Gospel message to be received and lived out in authentic community.

Day 17 - Theme: Outreach Strategies

Today, let us pray for innovative and effective outreach strategies to reach the diverse populations of South America. Ask God to inspire creativity and wisdom, guiding the local church leaders to tailor their approaches to the specific needs and cultural contexts of each community.

Day 18 - Theme: Language and Translation

Pray for language and translation efforts within the Anglican Church in South America. May the Scriptures, liturgies, and resources be translated accurately and effectively, ensuring that the message of God's love is accessible to people of different linguistic backgrounds.

Day 19 - Theme: Family and Marriage

In prayer today, lift up the families and marriages within the Anglican Church in South America. Ask for God's grace and guidance, that they may be strong foundations of faith and love, serving as beacons of hope and stability in their communities.

Day 20 - Theme: Interfaith Dialogue

Pray for fruitful interfaith dialogue and relationships in South America. May Christians engage respectfully and lovingly with people of different religious backgrounds, building bridges of understanding and pointing others towards the truth found in Christ.

Day 24 - Theme: Environmental Stewardship

In prayer today, lift up environmental stewardship efforts within the Anglican Church in South America. Ask for wisdom and a deep sense of responsibility to care for God's creation, promoting sustainable practices and advocating for the preservation of natural resources.

Day 25 - Theme: Healing of Divisions

Pray for the healing of divisions and conflicts within the Anglican Church in South America. May unity, reconciliation, and a spirit of love prevail, so that the Church can effectively demonstrate the transformative power of the Gospel to a watching world.

Day 26 - Theme: Strategic Partnerships

Intercede for the formation of strategic partnerships between Church, mission societies and other organizations in South America. Pray that God would align like-minded individuals and groups, fostering collaboration and maximising the impact of mission efforts in the region.

Day 27 - Theme: Leadership Development

Today, let us pray for the development of strong, godly leaders within the Anglican Church in South America. Ask that God would raise up individuals with servant hearts, wisdom, and vision, who will guide the Church with integrity and lead by example.

Day 28 - Theme: Community Development

Pray for community development initiatives within the Anglican Church in South America. May the Church actively engage in projects that promote education, healthcare, economic empowerment, and social justice, bringing holistic transformation to communities in need.

Day 29 - Theme: Mental Health and Well-being

In prayer today, lift up the mental health and well-being of individuals in South America. Ask for God's healing touch upon those struggling with depression, anxiety, trauma, or other mental health challenges, and pray for the provision of adequate support and resources.

Day 30 - Theme: Hope and Restoration

Pray for a renewed sense of hope and restoration to permeate the hearts of people in South America. May they encounter the life-transforming power of the Gospel, experience God's love, and find true purpose and meaning in their lives.



Day 31 - Theme: Thanksgiving and Praise
