But the non-existence of online teaching for months led to the creation of daily WhatsApp chats “I learn with Peter” (videos of songs and Bible story, plus craft activities), welcomed by many bored at home....

Being adaptable is essential, so providing “literacy” classes in Jan/Feb 2022 for 8-year-olds who had missed 2 complete school years was another way of showing that GOD CARES to children and their families.
