

Activity report for the month of July 2023.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Northern Ireland,

God is continuously good! This year we had a lot of things happening in Monte Horebe. We did two training sessions which are mandatory in Brazil. One was called Brigada de Incendio (Fire Brigade) and the second was First Aid. In addition to teaching things that are very important to children's lives, we are happy to comply with the laws concerning health and safety.

We also sent some of our dental staff on a Mission to riverside communities, people who live on the riverside and who do not have access to doctor, dentist or education. This was an invaluable project as, not only was time used to fix the teeth of people who were experiencing a lot of pain, but preventative treatment was given to children and adults and opportunities taken to talk to them about Jesus.

In Itaperucu itself many, many local children have used the gym to learn jiu-jitsu, Capoeira (a sport combining rhythmic dance, martial-arts, and acrobatic movements) and futsal (indoor football).

We have started a vegetable garden to produce food to be used for meals for Mount Horeb and soon we will have many vegetables and spices produced on our own farm.

In addition to these positive features, we want to share with you brothers and sisters important points for prayer:

• We really need the Brazilian government to grant us a Certificate called CEBAS, which is very important for Non Governmental Organisations, as it avoids the NGO having to pay some taxes as well as giving it some rights.

- We are also praying that God will give us resources for two needs: the first will be to replace our window frames which are 20 years old and, because they are made of metal, they have rusted, and are unsafe.
- Another need is a roof for the walkway children use to move from one building to another. On rainy days the children get moving from class to class as well as when going to the bathroom.

We believe that God will open the doors of heaven and give us the conditions to effect these changes.
