Because Ecuador is a hot country, it grows lots of foods and other things that we do not grow in England. Here are some examples, for you to colour in:



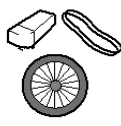
banana

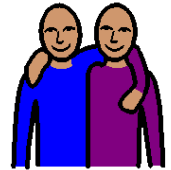
