Distribution of spectacles

Each year Mission Paraguay collects over 1000 pairs of second hand spectacles in the UK to be distributed to needy people in areas of Asunción, Concepción and the Chaco region of Paraguay. Many people are unable to pay the cost of visiting a local optician and are fitted with suitable spectacles using the expertise of Mission Paraguay volunteers but other people can afford to have new lenses fitted in the frames supplied.
