The construction of underground rainwater storage tanks in the Chaco

Mission Paraguay provides funding for the construction of underground storage tanks for rainwater gathered from roofs for use by local Indian families. There is no piped water supply in this area. When rainwater is unavailable water must be used directly from the local pond or swamp.

The construction is by local Indian builders. This provides work in an area with few employment opportunities.



Each tank holds 21,000 litres

The project is organised through missionary Chris Hawksbee who works to encourage self sufficiency amongst the Indian communities in the Chaco who are some of the most marginalised people in Paraguay.
