Now we want to start a new project to enlarge the one bathroom we have near the classrooms which is not enough now that we have 70 students. We pray that God will supply all that we need to complete the plan.

The 30th April is Teacher's Day here in Paraguay. We take advantage of that to give thanks for all the teachers who work with us in FEISA and to ask God to bless them abundantly. The day before we will have a tea for them.

At the end of March we had a lovely service for Easter. Thank you for praying for it. We are sending you some photos so that you can share our gratefulness. We don't want to miss any opportunity to share the gospel with our students which is a fundamental part of FEISA's vision.
