We here are enjoying our hot summer holidays, but we thank God that He's still working hard among us! He has been saving entire families in our community! Now that the kids are out of school there have been amazing things happening with our youth groups. Here are some highlights!

A word from God for us in 2011

### MOU CHILE

A total of 230 young people got together in Viña del Mar alone, as part of a 4 day nationwide, evangelistic, multi-denominational Christian outreach. 18 of our youth group took part, most of whom had never shared the gospel with a stranger before. Their experiences on the streets showed how God moved through them despite their fears, and they saw people genuinely touched and changed by the message of Jesus Christ. They were really blessed at the MOU evening services where all 230 congregated to hear the word and worship, where many of them had their first personal encounter with God. We also heard marvellous stories of unity as all the guys joined together around their common focus of Jesus, despite their denominational differences. ### YOUTH CAMP

We thank the Lord for a wonderful, fun and spiritually uplifting camp, where we had 38 young people, 7 of whom had never been to any sort of Christian activity before, but God had a purpose and all 7 gave their lives to the Lord! The young people also took on the responsibility of organising all the logistics of the camp, freeing us to focus on the pastoral care of the group.



As we were prayerfully preparing for it, the Lord showed us He wanted to bless each one of the young people in showing them how they were originally created, so they could live according to God's eternal purposes for their unique lives. We faced difficulties in every area of the organisation of the camp, particularly in finding adult leaders,

so the final team ended up being only Danny, Ary and Laura (our english visitor from ChristChurch Fulham). Praise God because He had a purpose all along. The Lord showed us to start praying for each of the leaders of the cell groups, and after doing so we saw His purpose to use those same young people to pray for the rest of their groups. It was amazing to see how the Lord spoke to them, giving them accurate words and visions to share, something that surprised most of them! Then it was clear to us why we didn't need more adults at the camp, and we thank God that there weren't more, so that He could use the young people to bless each other!



## 20+ YOUTH GROUP

In our last letter we wrote about the need for standing faithfully on God's vision for this group, and it has been really cool to see how God has fulfilled what He set out to do! Now this group is regularly meeting every week, made up of a growing number of young adults, with its own leaders who have taken the initiative and commitment to organise everything themselves.

He is looking into resitting the exams for the necessary grades, but also considering going to the UK to study. Please support him in prayer as he seeks the Lord's will in this.
