

News and Prayer Requests from the projects in Olinda, Brazil

- 1. Fantastic news!! The **Nestlé's project** submitted by Ian and Siméa has been chosen. There were 260 applications and 10 got through, Ian and Siméa's being one of them. It will run for one year and will be to teach families about health and nutrition plus sports. Ian and a nurse from the Presbyterian Church are in São Paulo for training. The project will run at Living Waters but be under the auspices of My Father's House.
- Urgent prayer is still required for qualified help at My Father's House. A social worker and psychiatrist are needed badly to work with the boys and their families.
- 3. The school term finishes soon for a month and a **holiday programme** is urgently required to keep the children at Living Waters and My Father's House occupied and helpers are needed to run it.
- 4. Please pray for **Jefferson** to have wisdom and guidance in his decision making. He has completed a year's course to go into the army and takes a test in February. However, he still feels called to mission. He wants to be confirmed by lan. He has a wife and family to support. I urge you to pray for confirmation of the right direction for him to go in at this time.
- 5. While the children are on holiday the two new **classrooms** and an enlarged **kitchen** are to be built. Prayer is required as funding is still needed for this project.
- 6. Special dates coming up:
 - Saturday 20th December, a big party for the Children
 - Sunday 21st December, a Christingle service
 - Christmas Day, the children are doing the Christmas story as a musical.
 80 children are taking part and 35 toddlers are going to be angels coming on at the end.
- 7. The **teenagers' group** of 13 to 17 year olds led by lan, Siméa, Elena and Juan are doing a comedy play with the animals in the stable telling the story.
