So now my new role is as pastor of the congregations of Prince of Peace Church in the suburb of Ciudad del Milagros, Salta, San Andres, and Grace Church in Tucuman. Please pray that God will give me the wisdom and strength to help these Churches to grow and develop, and to make an impact on their neighborhoods.

Pray too for the leadership training process.

1. The work with young people and teenagers. Pray that we will reach out to more young people, and pray especially for those who are going on camps in January and February.
2. EME is having a get-together at la Caldera on 13th November, with the aim of inviting all the women who have previously gone through EME, and we want to disciple them and bring them into the Church.
3. Pray for the Church in Tucuman, that they may be able to bring in new people through their evangelistic activities, and especially the cell groups, including the one that meets at Ramon and Gloria's house.
4. Pray for wisdom for Bishop Greg in his role in the North, especially with regard to the pastoral situation and the decisions which have to be taken about the weakest Churches.
5. San Pablo Church, which is struggling and losing its minister. Pray for guidance regarding new leadership.



6. The Church of San Pedro in Jujuy is under the supervision of Prince of Peace Church, but it is struggling and there are only seven people meeting together there every Sunday.
7. Pray for Rodolfo and Mercedes who are attending San Andres but working in San Felipe, a Church which is very small but growing.
8. Finally the Churches in Tartagal and Embarcacion, both very small groups without a minister.
